This section of The NEW Cyber Student Center (student.org) has an emphasis on preserving material for which I either have received the copyright or permission of the person while they were still able to give it This requires changes in the structure and procedures for student.org. The first section open to the public is in the library. It is named "the Campus Minister". I was granted the copy right in the final meeting of the Association of Southern Baptist Campus Ministers. That said should any author want their materials removed I will honor their wishes. The articles title will still be list but will indicate the content was removed at the request of the author or their family.

The drop-down menus to the right are broken down in a way I hope will ease locating materials by the year. One of the main

rationales for publishing old materials is to preserve them for any historical research.

I will only rarely make comments directly in the material unless I feel the comment will save the reader effort. An example is in Volume 22 in the article on websites recommended at that time. I have noted in red whether the website is still available.

I have undertaken this project at this time of life with the same sense of calling as I have experienced several times.
