MANUSCRIPTS for *The Campus Minister* are solicited and should be sent to Neal Schooley, 1015 W. University, Stillwater, OK, 74074. Articles must be professional in nature dealing with practical and theological issues in campus ministry. Articles should be 2,000-2,500 words (8 - 12 typewritten pages), doubled spaced, and conforming to an acceptable style guide. Complete bibliographic references are required, including year, volume, page, publisher, etc. A short biographical sketch on the author should accompany each manuscript.

Receipt of the manuscript will be acknowledged. Notification of acceptance can be expected as rapidly as possible within the constraints of professional review. Accepted manuscripts will be published in the first available issue, although the publications committee reserves the right to hold material for thematic treatment at a later date.
