The article should be in a WordPerfect format, but ASCII or other major wordprocessor formats are acceptable. Non-computer generated manuscripts should be typed and double-spaced on a 65-space line. All manuscripts should contain complete and accurate bibliographic information. Use endnotes and follow the latest edition of the Turabian style guide. Articles should be 2000-3000 words; reviews should be 500-800 words.
